Following our inspection by Ofsted on 26th and 27th March 2024, we are now able to share the final report with you all.

We are delighted to tell you that Ofsted have continued to judge St Luke's Halsall CE Primary School to be a GOOD school. We are extremely proud of this positive outcome which is a testament to the care and commitment of our staff and governors, the support of our parents and carers, and of course a celebration of our wonderful children.

We found the whole process really constructive and are pleased that the inspector commented favourably upon the pupils, their progress and our self-evaluation. The areas identified for improvement were already known to school leaders and we will be continuing with our action plan to address the issues detailed.

Some of the key findings are:

- **Children, 'are proud to be pupils at this school which has a special place in their hearts and prepares them well for the journey ahead.'**
- **The school has high aspirations for pupils' achievement. Pupils, including those with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND), achieve well. By the time that pupils leave Year 6, they are well prepared for secondary school.**
- **The school provides an ambitious curriculum.**
- **Pupils with SEND are well supported.**
- **Great emphasis is placed on pupils' personal development.**
- **Pupils behave well.**
